CONCERNING THE STATE COMMISSION ON JUDICIAL PERFORMANCE.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. 13-5.5-108, Colorado Revised Statutes, 1987
Repl. Vol., as amended, is amended to read:

13-5.5-108. Implementation of article. The
implementation of this article shall be subject to the
availability of funds received pursuant to section 13-5.5-107.
If funds received pursuant to said section are insufficient to
fully implement this article, the state commission shall
reduce the number of judicial districts in which district
commissions are established by section 13-5.5-104. ~~No general
fund appropriation for the purposes of this article shall be
made in the annual general appropriation bill but may be made
by separate bill.~~

SECTION 2. No appropriation. The general assembly has
determined that this act can be implemented within existing
appropriations, and therefore no separate appropriation of
state moneys is necessary to carry out the purposes of this
act.

SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby
